

THE BULLET ITSELF WAS TESTED






Old car batteries are smelted by secondary refiners



The bullet manufacturer extrudes the billets through dies, cutting the lead into separate wires.



Boxes are filled from bins, 25-50 bullets per box (typically).




The wires are cut into slugs of the proper size and then pressed into the



The bullets are dumped into bins as they are produced without regard for molten source.

 ❖ 1963 2004 OVER 2500 TESTS CONDUCTED
- LOOKED FOR SEVEN TRACE ELEMENTS
- ❖ UNITED STATES NATIONAL ACADEMY OF SCIENCES BOARD ON SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND ECONOMIC POLICY CONDUCTED INVESTIGATION
 - ❖ STATISTICS APPLIED CAUSED CONFUSION AND MISAPPLICATION WHEN USED BY PROSECUTORS
 - ❖ FBI "VOLUNTARILY" CEASE OFFERING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT
- ❖ According to FBI, 20% of the 2500 cases introduced at trial


