IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT (ICE) DETAINERS

BACKGROUND

8 C.F.R. §287.7 authorizes Immigration and Customs Enforcement Agency (ICE) agents to issue a detainer for the purpose of advising a local law enforcement agency that ICE is interested in a person in the custody of such agency, and to request that the agency hold that person for up to 48 hours, excluding weekends and federal holidays, after the person is otherwise entitled to be released from the criminal justice system. In 2014, the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit ruled in *Galarza v. Szalczyk*, No. 12-3991, that detainers issued under 8 C.F.R. § 287.7 are not mandatory orders, but merely nonbinding requests. Franklin County has a duty to respect the rule of law, consider and balance the welfare of its citizens and the costs of legal defense and legal liability arising from an erroneously-issued detainer, of which costs are not reimbursable by the federal government.

PURPOSE

To define how the Franklin County Jail will process a Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Customs Enforcement Detainer issued pursuant to the authority of 8 C.F.R. §287.7.

POLICY

1. The Franklin County Jail (FCJ) will allow ICE law enforcement officials access to daily population reports for investigative purposes.
2. FCJ will accept an Immigration Detainer (Detainer) issued by ICE law enforcement officers, or other persons authorized by law to issue such Detainer, for the purpose of identifying an inmate who is also an undocumented individual suspected of criminal behavior.
3. FCJ shall not detain any individual or maintain continuing custody of an inmate at the request of ICE unless ICE first presents the County with a judicially issued warrant or order authorizing such detention. FCJ will not detain an inmate or maintain continuing custody of an inmate based solely on a Detainer. While FCJ personnel will attempt to notify the originator of the Detainer of the pending release of the inmate who is the subject of the Detainer, FCJ will release the inmate at the appropriate date and time, regardless of whether or not ICE law enforcement officials are present to obtain custody of the inmate.
4. When FCJ personnel is made aware that an inmate is due for release from FCJ, appropriate personnel will:
 - a. Notify the official who issued the Detainer via the telephone number listed in the Detainer of the pending release of the inmate. This notification shall also be made via email if an email address was provided on the Detainer.

- b. Telephone calls and emails shall be logged in the appropriate FCJ records, noting the FCJ official making the call or sending the email, the date and time of the communication, who was spoken to and the information conveyed in the communication between parties.
- c. FCJ personnel shall include in the body of the email and in any telephone communications the following:
 - i. If ICE officers do not respond to assume physical custody of the inmate who is the subject of the Detainer prior to the release date and time, the individual will be released.
 - ii. No inmate who is the subject of a Detainer will be held past his or her release date and time based solely upon a Detainer.

AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

I, Cpl. Joseph Jakubik of the Chambersburg Police Dept, believe the following to be sufficient probable cause to charge the Defendant, Jackeline Maldonado-Negron, with one count Burglary, one count Terroristic Threats, one count Harassment, one count Criminal Mischief, and one count Driving Without a Valid License.

On 9-17-2018 at 0009 hrs, Ofc. Eaton and I responded to 673 Philadelphia Ave Apt 2 for the report of a female breaking into a residence. Prior to arrival, Franklin County Dispatch advised that the female made it into the residence and was in a physical altercation with the homeowner, Andris Lemus-Leiva. When we arrived at the residence, I could hear yelling coming from the second floor apartment.

We made contact with Lemus-Leiva and his wife, Milena. The Defendant was in the kitchen of their residence. She was bleeding from the hands and yelling at the Lemus-Leiva family. Andris pointed to a window and advised that the Defendant had broken the window which caused her injuries. Both panes of the window were shattered. He added that she did not live in the residence and was not a guest. The Defendant was speaking Spanish. She repeatedly stated that her girlfriend was in the residence. Andris advised that he had seen the Defendant in the past and believed that she was a jealous woman looking for her girlfriend. Andris added that the girlfriend, Nolvía Rodriguez, was not at the apartment. Andris stated that after the Defendant broke the window, he made contact with her at the front door. The Defendant pushed her way into the house and began assaulting him and his wife. Andris had scratches and cuts on his arms, shoulders, and left side of his body as well as blood from the Defendant's injured hands. The Defendant also threatened Andris stating that she had five men outside that would kill him if he didn't produce Nolvía.

After the Defendant's arrest, it was discovered that she had driven to the victim's residence and had struck a garage with Nolvía's car. The Defendant admitted to driving the vehicle without a license.

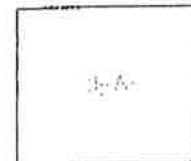

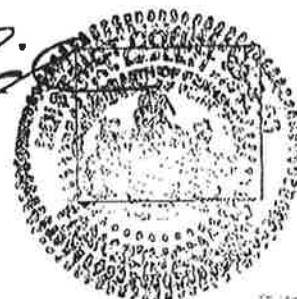

AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

I, Patrolman Cole Baker of the Chambersburg Police Department, believe the following to be true and sufficient probable cause to charge the defendant, Edwin Rodriguez, with (1) count of Simple Assault (M2) and (1) count of Disorderly Conduct (M3).

On 10/02/2016 at approx. 1910 hrs, CPD units were dispatched to 443 S Third St for a fight. When units arrived a male, identified as Nelson Rodriguez, was found sitting on the front porch of the residence. Rodriguez had obvious injuries to his face and neck. His nose appeared swollen, the right side of his face near his eye was swollen, he had several small lacerations to his face and other small contusions. There was also redness noticed to the neck area.

There was a language barrier between Rodriguez and officers but we were able to determine Rodriguez was assaulted by another male who was still in the residence. Rodriguez, who is the home owner, provided other officers with the keys to the residence, along with permission to enter. As units attempted to open the front door, it was quickly swung open by Edwin Rodriguez. Edwin was extremely confrontational with officers at first. Officers were able to get Edwin calmed down in a short time without incident.

While speaking with Edwin he admitted to assaulting Rodriguez due to comments that were made by Rodriguez to his girlfriend. Edwin stated the fight occurred in the back yard but claims it was mutual. During the fight Edwin was on top of Rodriguez punching him. Eventually Edwin was physically removed from Rodriguez by several of his friends. The friends were no longer at the residence when police arrived. Edwin did appear under the influence of alcohol while speaking with police.

Rodriguez was transported to the Chambersburg Hospital for treatment of his injuries.
