There is not a policy, directive, order, any training materials, or any other document that directs Upper Darby Police Officers to coordinate with the Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Custom's Enforcement agency.

The extent of support or coordination that the Upper Darby Township Police provide the Immigration and Custom's Enforcement agency consists of the following common practices:

1. When a person is arrested for a misdemeanor or Felony offense, he or she is fingerprinted through "AIFIS" to verify their identification and to gain access to their Criminal History. After they are fingerprinted the response may include that the person in custody has an outstanding warrant from another Jurisdiction. If there is an active warrant for the subject and the agency who holds the warrant is the Immigration and Custom's Enforcement agency, we would contact the agency as we would any law enforcement agency or jurisdiction.
2. The Upper Darby Township Police are on occasion are contacted and requested to assist an outside jurisdiction or agency with the warrant service of a person of whom that jurisdiction or agency has an active warrant within the boundaries of Upper Darby Township. The Upper Darby Township Police Department will support that agency with intelligence and/or any manpower if requested. This includes the Immigration and Custom's Enforcement agency as we would any law enforcement agency or jurisdiction.
