related commitments, New Paperwork Standards

If a new (ICE) commitment is brought into the prison with an ICE detainer only, do not accept the inmate. Immigration related only detainers, received from ICE, should not be honored unless they are accompanied by a Judicially Issued Warrant or Court Order authorizing such detention by the County. The ICE Detainer itself is not sufficient paperwork to commit the individual.

The same rules apply for an inmate who is already committed to our facility. Should RECORDS receive an ICE Detainer on someone who is already committed to our facility, the ICE detainer should be sent back to the ICE Agent (sending person), advising them that we do not accept ICE detainers unless they meet the above requirements.
