Keynote Speaker

Leonard Barrack FOX '65, LAW '68, HON '19



Leonard Barrack is the senior and founding partner of Barrack, Rodos & Bacine, a firm which litigates securities and antitrust class actions and complex commercial litigation. He attended Temple University for his undergraduate degree as well as the James E. Beasley School of Law, and has been giving back to the university ever since. In 2019, Barrack was awarded an honorary degree of humane letters in recognition of his many contributions to the university.

Since the enactment of the Private Securities Litigation Reform Act in late 1995, Barrack has been appointed lead or co-lead counsel in dozens of securities cases throughout the U.S., including three of the largest case settlements in securities class action history. These were *In re WorldCom, Inc. Securities Litigation* in the Southern District of New York; *In re Cendant Corporation Litigation* in New Jersey; and *In re McKesson HBOC, Inc. Securities Litigation* in the northern District of California.

Barrack was also the first person to represent an institutional investor, the Pennsylvania Public School Employees' Retirement System, as lead plaintiff in two major securities class actions initiated in early 1996.

A leader in Philadelphia's civic and political circles, Barrack was appointed by President William Clinton as the national finance chairman of the Democratic National Committee, and is the past president of the Jewish Federation of Greater Philadelphia.

His philanthropic efforts have included major gifts to Temple Law such as support for a significant expansion of the law school in 2002, in which the historic College Hall on North Broad Street was renovated and renamed the Morris and Sylvia Barrack Hall. Len Barrack and his wife, Lynne, also gave the law school the gifts of the Kohn and Weiner chairs, which are pivotal to attracting world-class legal scholars to the law school.

He also created the Barrack Public Interest Fellowship Program in 1991, which has benefited nearly 200 students. The aim of this fellowship was to remove some of the financial obstacles that so often discourage beginning lawyers from entering public interest jobs after graduation.

In 2002, Barrack was appointed by then-chairman of the board Howard Gittis and then-president David Adamany to chair Temple's first effort at a comprehensive capital campaign, which recently closed at \$30 million above its initial goal of \$350 million.

Today, Barrack is a member of the board of trustees of Temple University, and for many years he chaired the board's academic affairs committee. Barrack serves as the current chair of the board's alumni relations and development committee, and has served as chair of the Beasley School of Law Board of Visitors since 2008. Barrack's commitment to the university was recognized at the 2010 University Founder's Day, where he received the Alumni Distinguished Service Award. Also in 2010, the Student Public Interest Network honored Barrack with the Robert J. Reinstein Public Interest Award.

I pledge to respect the academic endeavor that I am about to undertake, and to uphold the honor and integrity of the legal profession that I seek to enter.

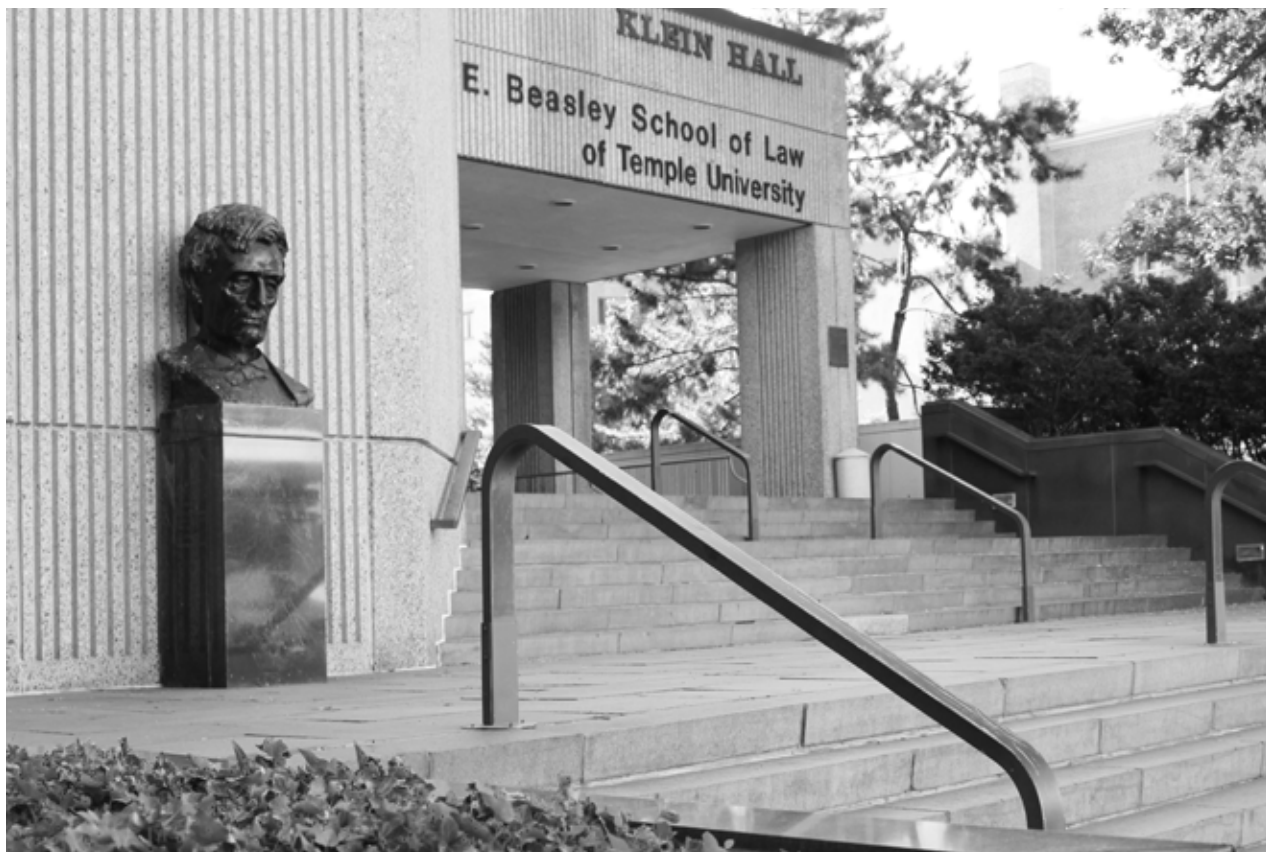

The Academic Procession and Regalia

THE ACADEMIC PROCESSION AND THE REGALIA worn by the faculty and officers of the University symbolically represent the continuing link between the modern American university and the founding of the great medieval universities in Europe—chief among them Bologna, Paris, and Oxford. As those institutions were derived from the Catholic Church, the universities adopted many of the ceremonial trappings of the church.

THE CAPS AND GOWNS worn in the procession also vary from place to place. Variations in design indicate the degrees held by the wearers, and many universities in the United States have introduced colorful gowns and other distinguishing details (in place of the customary clerical black from which all originated). The Bachelor's gown is a simple robe falling in straight lines from an elaborate yoke. Its distinguishing characteristic is the long, pointed sleeves. Master's gowns are arranged so that the arm emerges from a long sleeve through a slit at the wrist (replacing a former slit at the elbow). In most cases, the Doctor's gown is marked by velvet panels down the front and around the neck, and by three bars of the same material on the bell shaped sleeves. It is cut much fuller than the other gowns and may be ornamented in color. Faculty colors are occasionally seen in the sleeve bars and paneling.

THE CAPS also vary according to the customs of the university from which the wearer received a degree. Although most American universities adopted the "mortarboard" style of Oxford, others have chosen styles based on other European institutions. The color of the tassel worn with the cap may be black for any degree; or, the color may be that of the faculty of the major field of learning. Persons holding doctoral degrees and governing officials of institutions are entitled to wear tassels of gold metallic thread.

THE HOOD through length and color shows the degree and the specialization of the wearer, and the university that granted the degree. The color of the trim identifies the academic discipline. At the Law School graduation, the purple lining identifies the wearer as a recipient of a law degree.
